The Only Five-Diamond Private Club Lounge In New York City Opens This Week

The exclusive experience is positioned as a unique selling point of the hotel with curated dining experiences that include everything from a Champagne cart and caviar to wine and spirit tastings hosted by mixologists and renowned sommeliers. The exclusive wellness-inspired menu will include a rotating daily breakfast, lunch, and dinner menu with playful takes on classic ingredients and dishes. Guests can expect to find culinary offerings from local producers including Bouchon Bakery, Kings County Distillery, and Brooklyn Cured Meats.

"As New York City tourism continues to rebound, we are thrilled to open our beloved Club Lounge without limitations, just in time for the busy holiday season," General Manager Douglas Housley shared in a press release earlier this week.

Interested in experiencing the premium Club Lounge experience? Club Lounge access is included for specialty suite guests (including the Presidential, Royal, Artist Gate, Ritz-Carlton Suite and The Central Park Suite).
